Roundtable Discussion with the UK Shadow Foreign Secretary, Mr Douglas Alexander

Outcomes Report

The Australian Institute of International Affairs hosted a roundtable discussion for the UK Shadow Foreign Secretary Mr Douglas Alexander on Friday 28 June 2013 at the AIIA National Office Conference Centre. Mr Alexander expressed an interest in an interactive dialogue with an expert audience while on a one-week visit to Australia (24-29 June) as a guest of the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade under the Special Visits Program (SVP).

The event began with a welcome by AIIA Executive Director Melissa Conley Tyler. Mr Alexander then made some opening remarks emphasising the importance of the United Kingdom's relationship with Australia. Following on from these introductory remarks, the subsequent discussion included topics such as transitions in Asia, Australia-UK relations and the role of the UK as a crucial entryway for Australians in Europe. The roundtable brought together a number of Australia's foremost experts on those issues and Mr Alexander did not hesitate to ask these experts a wide range of questions.
